Length: 4 minutes
Setting: Outside

(LARRY is jumping around; he can't help himself. This is setting the stage—can be as short or as long as the actor needs.)

LARRY: Whoooooo. (Stops, does a standing broad jump.) That's a personal best!

(Leaps again.) That's a personal best!!

(BILL enters; is noticed by LARRY.)

LARRY: Bill!! Bill! Gosh, I'm out of shape. Bill!

BILL: I'm sorry. Do I know you?

LARRY: Yes, yes you do. Of course you do. (*More running and jumping.*) Watch!

(Does a very peculiar move, he doesn't really move very well, he is just excited to

be able to move.)

BILL: That's very ... Well, it's very.

LARRY: Wait, Wait, I've got another one.

BILL: I'm sure you do. Here. (*Tries to give him some money*.)

LARRY: Bill, it's me.

BILL: I think you have the wrong person.

LARRY: Wait, wait, maybe this will help. (*Lies down in a position of begging. Arms* 

*up?*)

BILL: (Sees him differently now.) Larry?

LARRY: (Turns away, bends over.) Kick me.

BILL: What?

LARRY: Kick me.

BILL: No, I'm not going to kick you.

LARRY: Come on, right here, give me a good one.

BILL: No.

LARRY: Chicken, chicken, can't get your leg that high, old man. Might pull a

hammy. Just an old, tough chicken, ready for the boiling ... (*He gets kicked, while in the middle of doing a chicken imitation.*) Ow!!! That hurts ... see that ... oh, that hurts ... son of a ... (*Pause—a realization that it's great to feel.*) It hurts!! I felt that!! Really hurts. There are nerve endings that go

right up the old ... boy, that hurt. That's great!! (Hugs Bill.)

BILL: You're nuts.

LARRY: Absolutely! I'm positively ... head rush. I gotta sit—I don't wanna sit ...

not gonna sit.

BILL: Larry. What happened?
